

Student access to computers is one way that Greenwood 50 enhances the learning opportunities for our students. Use of the device is a privilege. Students who use a computing device at school are expected to follow Greenwood 50's policies, procedures and practices. These are available in hardcopy and on the district web site.

Students and parents are encouraged to purchase the **School District Chromebook Protection Plan**. <u>The cost of the School District Chromebook Protection Plan is \$50 annually</u> and is nonrefundable. It is imperative that the device the student is issued be maintained and handled in a responsible way. If needed, a payment plan is available through your school and **must be paid in full by October 19, 2017**. The School District Chromebook Protection Plan does not go into effect until full payment of \$50 has been received.

Chromebook replacement and determination of negligence will be at the discretion of the administration. In addition, cosmetic/superficial damage which does not negatively impact performance or usability of the device will not be repaired unless it becomes a functionality problem at a later date.
